Servant Steward Mindset

- Increased titles often provide more opportunities to serve.
- It's not about you it's about the person served.
- Inverted leadership pyramid leader not at the top of the pyramid, but at the bottom.

Servant Steward Mindset

Yes – There will be decisions only the leader can make or recommend to the Board; however, a support-andserve leadership model should be present rather than a command and control distinctive.

No Margin – No Mission

Financial Margin – Primary Focus

God's direction day-by-day and what He would have you do rather than on how much money you want or need to have.

No Margin – No Mission

Serve Margin

- Be available to serve for whatever.
- Ex.The Good Samaritan
- Be prepared to stop, look, and listen.

No Margin – No Mission

Personal/Professional Margin

- Work effectiveness decreases after x number of hours.
- Allow for time to think and mull
 - Ex. Exercise at the YMCA

No Margin – No Mission

Personal/Professional Margin

- Spend time with the Bible each day.
 - Ex. Daily Audio Bible, Chronological
- Practice shutdown days to do whatever.
 - Ex. Set aside Sundays to be different than any other day in the week.
